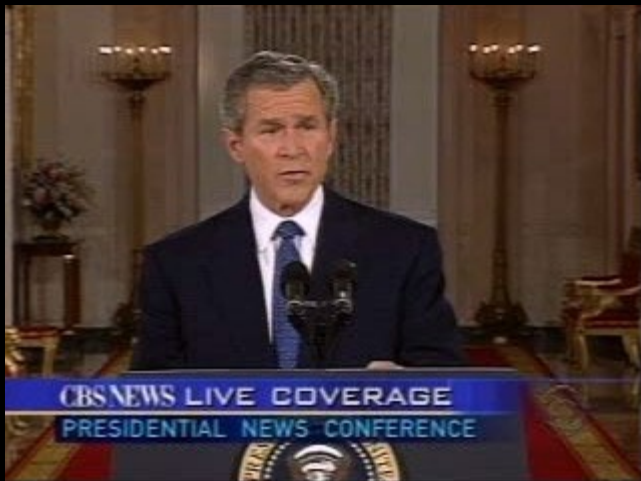
Morgan: Hi there! Welcome to the first ever all-Morgan Webb edition of the Screen Savers!

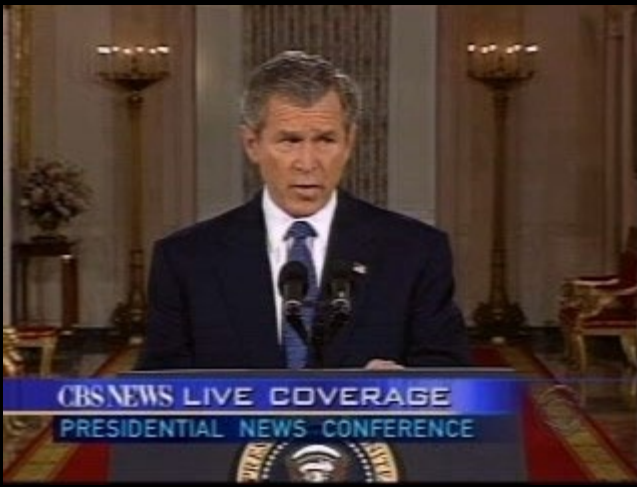

George W. Bush: My fellow Americans. Tonight I am here to give you an update on the war ...



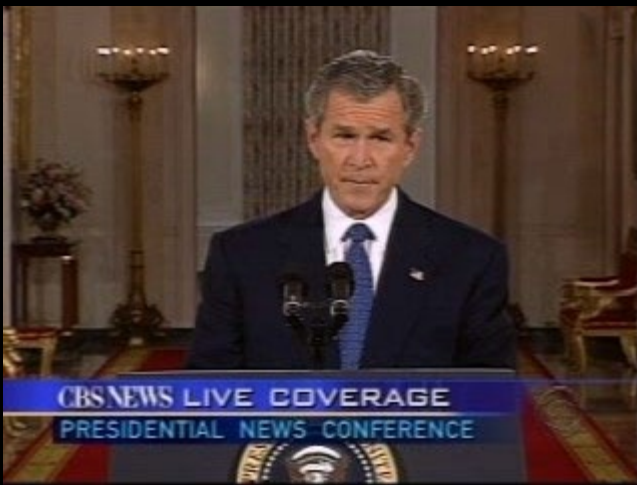

George W. Bush: Partner, I can see how you'd be confused as this one keeps being dropped from the scorecard like a non-hanging chad. Heh. Heh. Topical.



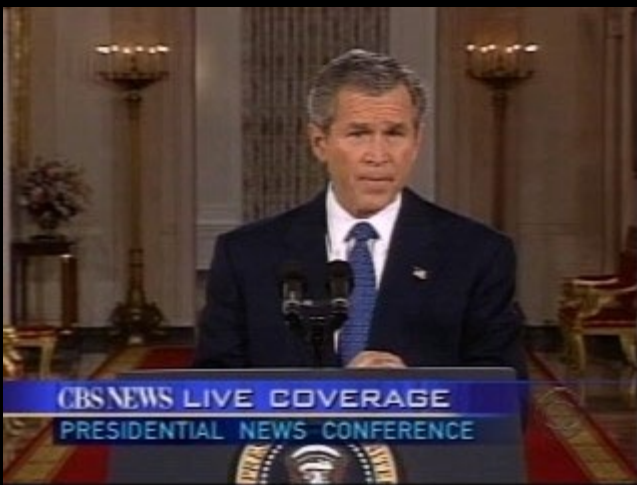
Reporter: What are you talking about sir?

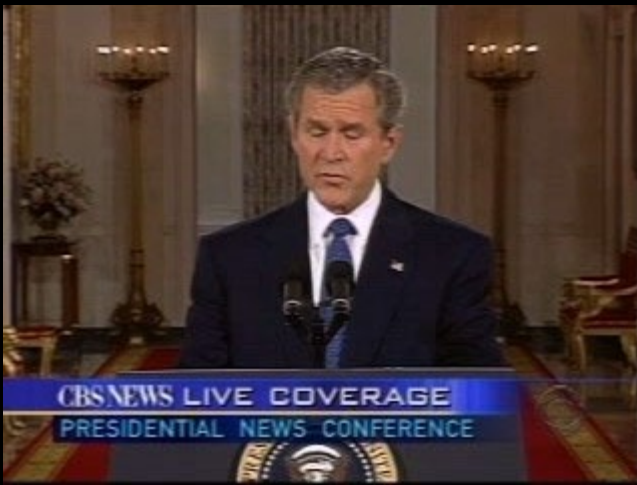
Reporter: No.



George W. Bush: Someone have that man removed and shot please.



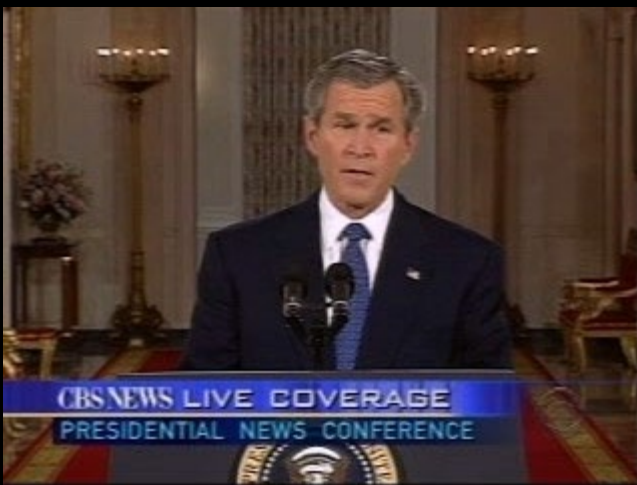
Reporter: Very funny, sir!

 George W. Bush: Now does anyone else question my sense of humor?



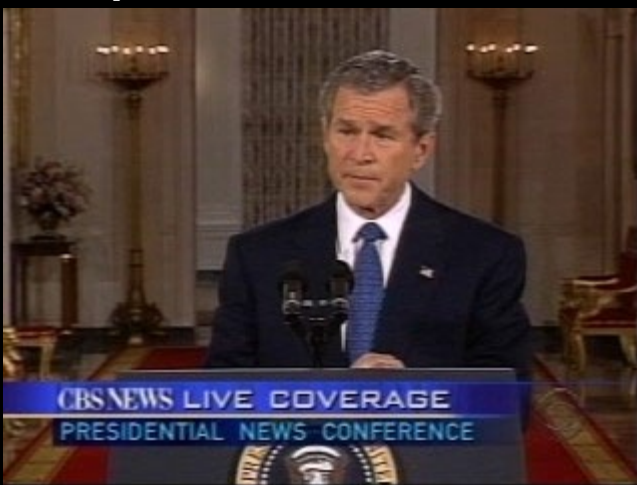
All: No sir! We love America! We love George W. Bush! All hail the second coming! All hail!



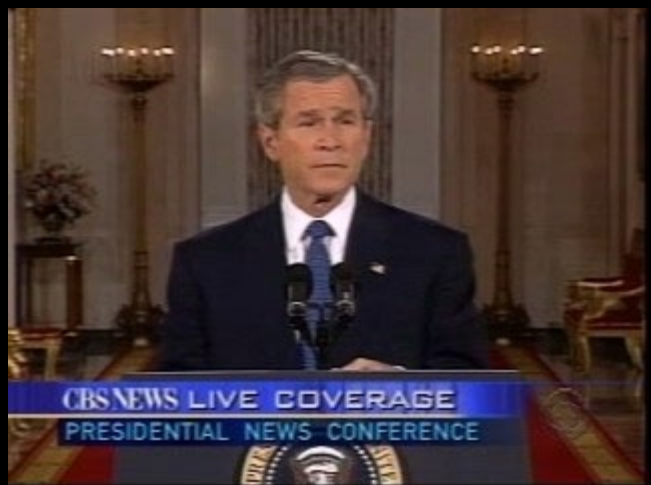
George W. Bush: Good, that's better. If the Democrats would react that way whenever I had one of their members publicly eliminated the world would be a better place.



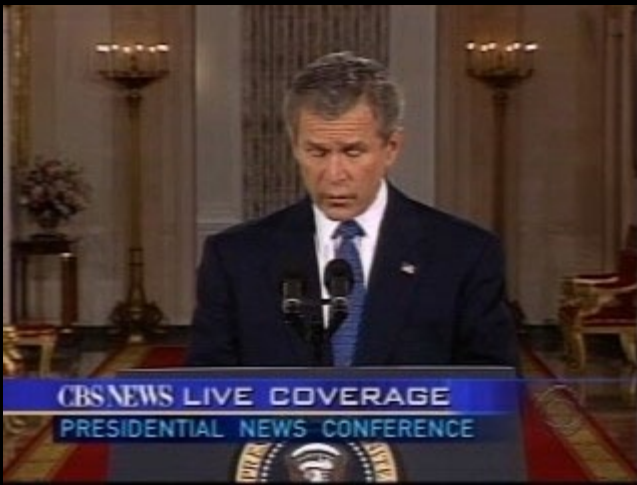
All: Hahahahahahaha!



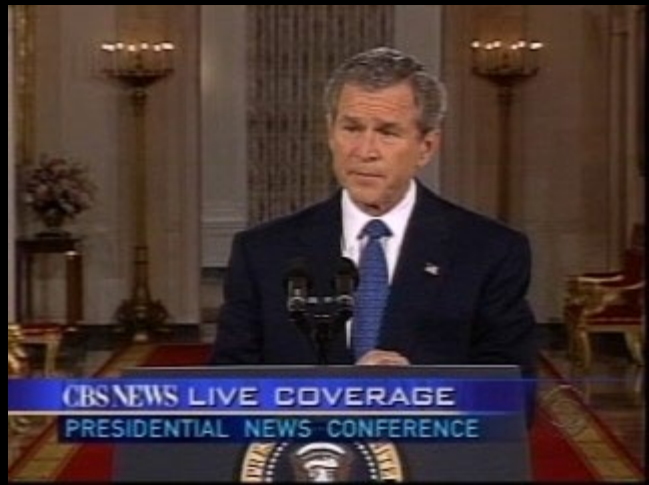

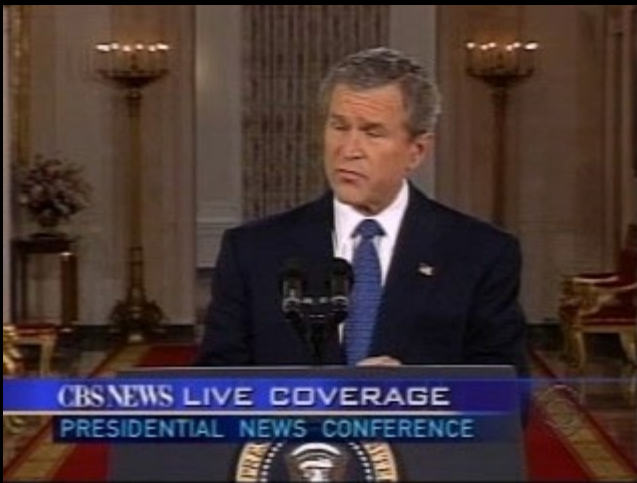

George W. Bush: Most recently the man has offered to surrender himself if I defeat him in a public debate. While I laugh at that prospect, I have decided to accept his challenge.



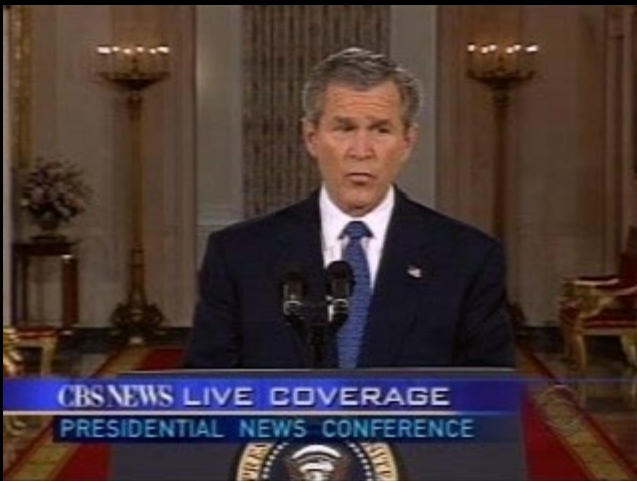
George W. Bush: Since he has agreed to let me set the rules of the debate it will take the form of 10 rounds of heavyweight boxing on the Showtime cable network.



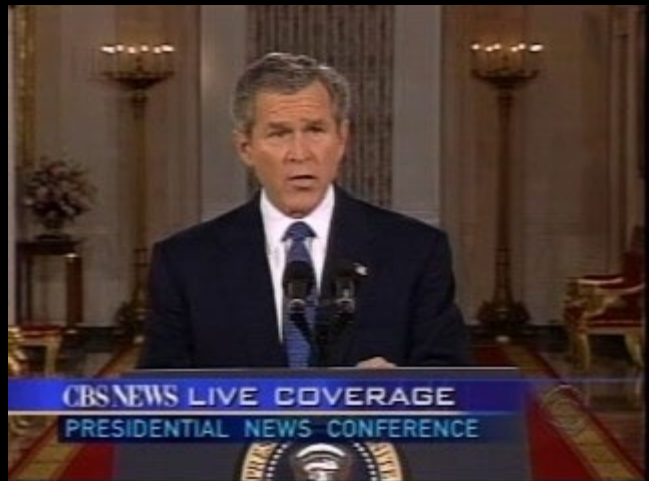
